SPECIAL EDITION FOR HURRICANE RELIEF

"It's Indescribable" screamed the headlines of the Courier Journal on September 1st. Southern Baptists have always responded to disaster relief and this will be no different. How can you help? We list four ways for you to do so

- ◆ **Pray** - When you pray remember the volunteers who are serving as well as the victims. You should also include the utility workers, insurance adjusters and employees of volunteer agencies such as the Salvation Army and Red Cross.
- ◆ **Make A Donation** - We recommend you make your donation to the North American Mission Board (NAMB). While other agencies are also collecting funds, this is the one fund where 100% of your donations will be used for relief. Check with your church because many are collecting offerings. If you do so individually make your check out to NAMB and write Hurricane Relief on the notation line. Send it to our State Convention at P. O. Box 24189, Indianapolis, IN 46224.
- ◆ **Collect Cleaning Equipment**— When we are called, our assignment will be storm and flood cleanup. It may be mid to late September before we are mobilized because NAMB is using volunteers in waves. Right now those helping in feeding stations and cleaning debris are there. What kind of supplies do we need?
 - ◆ ANTIBACTERIAL CLEANERS
 - ◆ MOPS AND SPONGES
 - ◆ BUCKETS
 - ◆ PLASTIC GLOVES AND WADERS
 - ◆ WET-DRY VACS
 - ◆ GENERATORS
 - ◆ EXTENSION CORDS
 - ◆ BOTTLED WATER

You can bring these supplies to our Ministry Center in New Albany. Check our website for directions or call us at (812) 948-8777.

- ◆ **Volunteers to Go**— We will be assigned an area by NAMB and will probably know where that is by September 10th. If you can go, call or email us being sure to give us your phone number. We will need vans to carry volunteers and supplies as well as a pickup truck to take our Disaster Relief trailer to the scene.
- ◆ **Pray**— I know, I already said that but it seems a fitting place to begin and end. This time pray for your direct involvement in any or all of these levels of relief.
