Smaller Churches Having A Great Summer

Three of our smaller churches have things to celebrate; two are our very newest and the other is one of our oldest.

First Baptist of Alton has been around for nearly 150 years and averages in the mid 20's on Sunday morning. They had not had a baptism in 10 years but this summer they baptized one and two others made profession's of faith and are awaiting baptism.

Lighthouse Baptist in Borden began this January and they hosted a mission team from Longwood Florida. Over the five days of ministry, they handed out 4500 VBS flyers and contacted 1500 homes. In addition, they conducted a revival each night with an average attendance of 50 to 60, mounted a steeple and built a sound booth in the sanctuary.

Calvary Community in Utica held two block parties in July. Established this January, they continue to grow reaching the new subdivisions and apartment complexes in this area. A highlight of one of the block parties was an 11 year old girl from Calvary leading another girl to Christ.
